Now, on the 20th day of June 2024 the above captioned matter came on for consideration before the Public Employees Relations Board.



Include: Assistant Range Master, Police Recruit, Police Officer, Police Detective, and Police Sergeant.


Exclude: All other employees not specifically listed.





RIGHT TO REQUEST HEARING


