Laboratory Specialist, Utility Locator, Vehiole/Equipment Mechanic, Veterinary Nurse I, Veterinary Nurse III, Welder

Exclude: Office, clerical employees, all professional employees, elected and management employees, officials, uniformed police employees, security guards, and supervisory and confidential employees as defined in the Act under K.S.A. 75-4322, and all temporary, student and emergency employees.

Pursuant to the mutual agreement of the parties, and by the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employer Employee Relations Act (K.S.A. 75-4321, et seq.), including the authority granted pursuant to K.S.A. 75-4327(c) and K.S.A. 76-4323(e)(3), it is hereby ordered to adopt the name change of the unit and job classifications as noted ofted.
