#### ORDER

The Public Employee Relations Board of the State of Kansas hereby enters the following order:

The Board has before it the petition by Teamsters Local Union 696 seeking to represent the employees currently working in the Street Maintenance Division of the City of Topeka, Kansas. These employees are currently included in a unit consisting of employees working in the Street Maintenance Division and Water Pollution Control Division of the City of Topeka. The current unit was found to be an appropriate unit in PERB Case No. UE 5-1973.

The Board has considered the submissions of the parties and has determined that the current unit is no longer appropriate. Based on the submissions of the parties, and taking into consideration the principle of efficient administration of government, the community of interest among the affected employees, the history of employee organization, the geographical location of the affected employees, as well as the effects of overfragmentation and splintering of the work organization, the Board finds separate units consisting of employees of the Street Maintenance Division and Water Pollution Control Division to be appropriate units under the Act.
