INCLUDE: All employees at KU Medical Center as listed below. (All employees holding permanent, provisional, probationary, part-time, intermittent and in-lieu-of appointments will be included.)

EXCLUDE: Office, clerical, guards, professional employees, licensed practical nurses, registered nurses and supervisors as defined in the Act under Section 75-4322(b). (All employees appointed on a temporary, seasonal, student, emergency and exceptional basis will be excluded.)
