
and a showing of interest of 30 percent has been received from PEAK and from KAPE, this Board orders that an election be held on October 23, 1973 from 12:00 Noon to 4:30 p.m. in the Blueprint Room 2A of the Physical Plant, located on the University campus, for the purpose of determining whether the aforesaid employees want to be represented by: (1) Public Employees Association of Kansas (PEAK); (2) Kansas Association of Public Employees (KAPE); or (3) No Representation.

We will need assistance from the employer and employees on the date of the election to provide identification of each eligible employee voting so that their names can be checked off the eligible employee voters list. PERB rule 84-2-12 allows for observers. The Board allows the public employer one observer and the public employees two observers, one representative in behalf of each employee organization.

All parties are required to be at the polling area by 11:30 a.m. on the date of the election in order for the Board Agent to go over election procedure.

Enclosed are NOTICE OF ELECTION sheets, sample BALLOT forms, and an INSTRUCTION TO ELECTION OBSERVERS sheet. The public employer is hereby ordered to post the NOTICE OF ELECTION sheets and sample BALLOT forms in places conspicuous to all employees.
