The Public Employee Relations Board rule 84-2-12 allows for observers. The Board allows the public employer one observer and the public employee one observer.



## ORDER

The above entitled matter came before the Board on March 15, 1973 for determination of the appropriate unit. The Board finds that on February 27, 1973, Local 806, AFL-CIO filed a petition purporting to be for unit determination and certification of an employee organization. Further by order of this Board, on March 6, 1973, the public employer (City of Hays) had until March 14 to object to said petition or allegations of said petition would be deemed admitted. An amendment to the unit involved was made on March 9, signed by both the employer and employee organization representatives. The Board further finds that no objection has been filed, that the time in which to file such objection or answer has expired, and that the unit herein should be determined as set forth in the petition and amendment filed by Local 806, AFL-CIO.

It is therefore ordered that the appropriate unit in this matter before this Board concerning certain employees in the City of Hays, Kansas shall be as follows:

INCLUDE: Police Patrolman, Police Sergeant, Police Lieutenant,

Dispatcher-Clerk, Detective, Chief Dispatcher-Clerk,

Community Relations Officer

EXCLUDE: Police Captain and Police Chief
