

O R D E R

It having been determined that the appropriate unit in the above matter is as follows: INCLUDE: All full-time or regular part-time personnel classified as Aide I, Cook I, Porter I, Aide II, Cook II, Harwald Machine Operator I, Porter II, Aide III, Tool Crib Clerk II, Cook III, Porter III, Custodian I, Aide IV, Tool Crib Clerk III, Custodian II, Aide V, Crewman I, Driver I, Custodian III, Engineer I, Stock Clerk I, Crewman II, Driver II, Leadman I, Stock Clerk II, Technician I, Aide VII, Crewman III, Driver III, Leadman II, Stock Clerk III, Technician II, Minority Guidance Advisor, Crewman IV, Stock Clerk IV, and Leadman III; EXCLUDE: Certified or other professional employees, supervisory employees, confidential employees (which includes full-time and regular part-time clerical and secretarial employees), temporary and substitute employees, Custodial Aides I, II, and III, lunch period aides, office education clerks, security or patrol guards, firemen, matrons and investigators, and elected and management officials (a regular part-time employee shall be construed an employee who customarily works more than 20 hours a week),

We will need assistance from the employer and employees on  
the date of the election to provide identification of each eligible  
employee voting so that their names can be checked off the eligible  
employee voters list.

The Public Employee Relations Board rule 84-2-12 allows for  
observers. The Board allows the employer one observer at each  
poll and the public employee one observer at each poll.

TIONS TO ELECTION OBSERVERS sheets are being send under separate  
cover. The public employer is hereby ordered to post the NOTICE  
OF ELECTION sheets and sample BALLOT sheets in places conspicuous  
to all employees.
