The parties submit that the above Case 72-CAE-2024 has been resolved pursuant to the following agreement:

Respondent, USD 261 Haysville Schools ("District"), after well-intentioned attempts to collaborate, surveyed a small subset of the bargaining unit on a topic of negotiations for the 2023-2024 contract. Regardless of the District's efforts to act in good faith and respect the bargaining agent, the survey had the potential to interfere with the Haysville Education Association's ("HEA's) exclusive right to represent the bargaining unit. In the future, the District will not survey members of the bargaining unit on bargaining issues without consent of HEA. The District and HEA remain committed to bargaining in good faith.

After review of the parties' agreement and Joint Motion to Dismiss, and being fully and duly apprised of the matter, I find that the parties' Joint Motion to Dismiss is granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUGED, AND DECREED that the above captioned case is hereby DISMISSED.
